Indigo Dye Day at Ossabaw Island

Sunday, October 4, 2015 - 9am to 5pm

Donna Hardy of Sea Island Indigo has promised to give us a fun-filled day at historic Ossabaw Island exploring blue indigo among the indigo plants growing on the island. She will prepare 4 vats of indigo dye - 2 for plant (cellulose) fibers and 2 for animal (protein) fibers - for us to dip our own yarns and fabric to transform them with beautiful shades of indigo blue.

You can dye old stained textiles, things that are yellowed, tableclothes, napkins, old doilies, clothing to re-dye, jeans, tee shirts, and/or any clothing that is the appropriate fiber. Just make sure it's scoured and/or clean and ready to dye. We will have basic shibori materials like rubber bands and some clamps. If you prefer, bring your own shibori supplies.

COST: \$110 for current Fiber Guild of the Savannahs members includes day pass and boat \$135 for non-members - includes membership, day pass & boat

The boat leaves promptly from Delegal Marina at the Landings on Skidaway Island, GA - one at 9:00am & one at 9:30am. No refunds for those who miss the boat! Participants should bring a bag lunch. Class size is limited so register TODAY!
